8 WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein proudly 9 conveyed to Ms. Gwendolyn Denice Richardson for being 10 inducted into the 3rd Class of J.F. Shields/Monroe County 11 Training School Athletic Hall of Fame; and

12 WHEREAS, Ms. Richardson was born on August 7, 1958, 13 in Beatrice, Alabama, to the late Earvin Lee Richardson and 14 the late Bernice Johnson Richardson; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Richardson graduated from J.F. Shields 16 High School as Valedictorian in 1976; she achieved a 17 plethora of accomplishments during her high school years, 18 including, but not limited to, writing articles for The 19 Monroe Journal, participating in the band as a flute player from 1970-1976, being selected in the 1976 edition of "Who's 20 21 Who Among Music Students in American High Schools", and 22 being selected as J.F. Shields High School's 1976 Betty Crocker Family Leader of Tomorrow for outstanding 23 performance and superior knowledge demonstrated in the 24 25 examination of family life knowledge and attributes of the

26 Betty Crocker Search of Leadership in Family Living; since 27 2009, she has served as her high school's photographer for 28 basketball, football, and other school functions; and 29 WHEREAS, Ms. Richardson has been serving as the Monroe County Commission Administrator for over 20 years as 30 31 the first Black person hired in the position; one of her 32 most noteworthy accomplishments during her career was when she led her team from a paper based yellow worksheets system 33 to a fully automated computerized system, significantly 34 improving and streamlining the overall operation of the 35 36 office; and

37 WHEREAS, Ms. Richardson has been involved in all levels of the Association of County Administrators of 38 39 Alabama (ACAA), serving as Second Vice President in 2006, First Vice President in 2007, and President in 2008; she has 40 41 been a member of the ACAA Board of Directors for 15 years 42 and currently serves as a member of the Legislative 43 Committee; she also served as the District 10 Representative 44 from 2003 to 2005; and

WHEREAS, an immensely distinguished woman indeed, some of Ms. Richardson's other achievements include being selected by the Association of County Commissions of Alabama to serve as a member of the Modernization III Policy Team from 2014 to 2015; serving as the local chairperson of the 2020 Census Monroe County Complete County Committee, where

51 she organized an unprecedented campaign to raise awareness 52 and educate the citizens of Monroe County on the importance 53 of standing up and being counted in the 2020 Census; being a 54 life member of the Auburn University Alumni Association; and 55 being recognized and honored by the ACAA as the recipient of 56 the coveted John Gordon County Administrator of the Year 57 Award; and
