BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF

THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the Legislature condemns these brutal acts of hate perpetrated against the Jewish community because these are cowardly attacks on our residents, our community, and our freedoms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this body stands with

the Jewish community and others affected by these threats.
