6	WHEREAS, Saint Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland,
7	is known for bringing Christianity to Ireland, and with it,
8	literacy and learning; the island was known as the "isle of
9	saints and scholars" by the early Middle Ages; and
10	WHEREAS, although Catholics continue to celebrate
11	feast days of the saints around the world, only Saint
12	Patrick's feast day is celebrated so widely,
13	enthusiastically, and across denominations, showing the
14	diaspora of Irish people and influence around the world; and
15	WHEREAS, long before the popular secular celebrations
16	that we know today, the first celebration honoring Saint
17	Patrick occurred in the Spanish colony of Florida in the
18	settlement of St. Augustine in 1600 with the firing of
19	canons and the first modest parade in his honor followed a
20	year later; now, cities across the United States and around
21	the world host large festivities of parades and cultural
22	celebrations; and
23	WHEREAS, although the Irish arrived in the colonies
24	with settlers from Great Britain and made their homes in the
25	Northeast and Appalachia, many more emigrated seeking relief
26	from the Irish potato famine from 1845 to 1855 and created
27	pockets of communities in the States, from the East Coast to

28 the West Coast; their culture has become part of the

30 WHEREAS, there are 44,000,000 Americans of Irish 31 ancestry spread across this great nation and contributing to 32 science, education, art, agriculture, business, industry, 33 literature, music, athletics, entertainment, government, and 34 military service; now therefore,
