7 WHEREAS, it is with profound sadness that we note the 8 death on May 19, 2023, of Attorney Carolyn Diane Gaines-9 Varner, of Selma, Alabama, at the age of 72 years; and

10 WHEREAS, from the moment of her birth on March 22, 11 1951, Carolyn Gaines-Varner was destined for greatness - a 12 daughter, wife, mother, friend, and a great servant; and 13 WHEREAS, beginning her academic climb to excellence

at George Clem School, she soared as a student and

15 continued as she graduated from Parker High School in 1969 16 in Birmingham, Alabama; Mrs. Gaines-Varner graduated from 17 Fisk University with honors in three years; in 1972, she 18 began her studies at Boston College Law School; there she 19 met her soulmate Perry Varner, Jr; after graduation they 20 both moved to Selma to work at Chestnut, Sanders, and 21 Sanders Law Firm where she worked for over 30 years; and

22 WHEREAS, on September 15, 1979, Carolyn and Perry 23 became partners in marriage and movement; joining forces 24 with other activists, they co-founded the Bridge Crossing 25 Jubilee and the National Voting Rights Museum where she 26 served as the President of the Board until the time of her 27 death; and

Jack and Jill, and Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated; but above all, she was a woman of God and a lover of children, community, and justice; she served with dignity, love, and compassion; she always opened her home to those in need; she enjoyed hosting events, shopping, and eating out with loved ones; and

35 WHEREAS, Mrs. Gaines-Varner was preceded in death by 36 her beloved husband, Perry Varner, Jr; her parents, Rev. 37 Damon and Ora Lee Gaines; and her brother, Harold Gaines; 38 and
