WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we recognize Limestone County's Sheriff Deputy Jake Abernathy as a nominee for the 2022 Alabama Legislative Law Enforcement Medal of Honor, Alabama's highest law enforcement award for extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Abernathy's heroic actions on July 15, 2021, assisted in saving the life of a swimmer drowning near the Easter Ferry Bridge in Limestone County, Alabama; responding to the call, while off duty and on his way home after working his own shift, Deputy Abernathy arrived first at the perilous scene to find a struggling swimmer about 800 yards from the bridge; Deputy Abernathy began attempting to rescue the swimmer; despite his best efforts and because of the swift current of the river, Deputy Abernathy lost his grip on the swimmer, who subsequently floated down river; Deputy Abernathy again courageously swam to the individual, grabbed

him, and pulled him as far as he could near the shoreline, but they both began to go under the water; and

WHEREAS, at this point, his colleague, Deputy Lucas
Ferrell arrived on the scene and without regard to his own
safety, entered the tumultuous water, swam to Deputy
Abernathy's location in the river, and was able to help him
and then gain control of the victim who was in and out of
consciousness; Deputy Abernathy, along with Deputy Ferrell,
brought the swimmer close to the shoreline; with the
assistance of other first responders on the scene, the swimmer
was pulled from the water to safety; Deputy Abernathy's
selfless actions led to the swimmer being rescued and then
transported to a hospital, where he made a full recovery; and

WHEREAS, there is no greater accomplishment than to seek to successfully rescue a fellow citizen whose life is imperiled; Deputy Abernathy is a worthy exemplar of those caring and dedicated men and women who stand ever ready to provide prompt and professional response in times of crisis, and he is highly deserving of this distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor; now therefore,
