WHEREAS, Reverend Hayden served as Pastor of Jerusalem Baptist Church in Porter, Alabama, and had served as Pastor of New Jerusalem Baptist Church for 28 years; he also was a Certified Teacher of the National Sunday School Publishing Board and the President of the Congress of Christian Education for the Walker County Young Ministers Association; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Hayden earned his Bible Diploma from The Birmingham Easonian Baptist Bible College in Birmingham, Alabama, in May 1990; his Bachelor of Theology Degree in May 1995; and his Master of Arts in Biblical Studies and his Master of Arts in Ministry with a Concentration in Pastoral Leadership from The Birmingham Theological Seminary; and

WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his parents; son, Gordon W. Hayden; brother, Nathaniel Griffin; and sister, Mary Leonora Hayden; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Hayden is survived by his devoted wife, Sonya L. Hayden; sons, George W. Hayden, Jr. (Ebony), Gregory W. Hayden (LaQuita), Reuben Woods (Lauren), and Roderick Hayden (J'Aime'); daughter, Domonique Stinson;
