15 from Booker T. Washington High School and was a devout member
16 of Bethel Baptist Missionary Church since 1934; and

17 WHEREAS, she was a longtime resident of AHEPA 23
18 Apartments in Downtown Montgomery; and

19 WHEREAS, through the years, she was an advocate in
20 the Civil Rights Movement and an active member of the
21 Montgomery Improvement Association and the NAACP; and

22 WHEREAS, she was a resident of Cleveland Court
23 Housing for 15 years and received a well-deserved award for
24 her dedicated service in 2009; she was also recognized for 30
25 years of commitment to her Eastern Star Lodge and to the City
26 of Montgomery; and

1 WHEREAS, she was employed as an elevator operator at
2 the Jefferson Davis Hotel and devoted 15 years of service to
3 Union Bank, where she used her position to open doors of
4 opportunity for people in the Cleveland Court community; and

5 WHEREAS, Carrie Perdum Carter was a valued member of
6 the community; although her presence will be greatly missed,
7 her legacy will endure and her memory will be cherished in the
8 hearts of those who were fortunate to know her; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
10 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Carrie Perdum
11 Carter is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is
12 offered in tribute to her life and with heartfelt sympathy to
