11 death on April 7, 2017, of Mr. Robert Edward Henry of Decatur,
12 Alabama, at the age of 90 years; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
14 his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Henry was born on February 13, 1927, in
17 Birmingham, Alabama, and was the first of six children born to
18 Anthony George Henry and Maudie Terrell Henry; and

20 Corps, he earned his Bachelor of Science Degree in Natural
21 Science from Miles College and his Masters Degree from Alabama
22 A and M University; and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Henry began his teaching career at
24 Morgan County Training School in 1950 and taught at Lakeside
25 High School and Decatur High School before retiring in 1985;

1 WHEREAS, after retiring, Mr. Henry worked for First
2 American bank for 14 years; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Henry was a faithful and dedicated
4 member of King's Memorial United Methodist Church where he
5 sang in the choir, served on the Trustee Board, was a Sunday
6 School Teacher, and bible study attendee; and

7 WHEREAS, he was a dedicated member of Omega Psi Phi
8 Fraternity, Incorporated, River City Golfers, Red Cross Board,
9 Alabama Education Association, National Education Association,
10 and Morgan County Education Retirees Association; and

11 WHEREAS, survivors include his devoted and faithful
12 wife, Katherine E. Driver Henry; daughter, Cheryl Coleman
13 (Chuck); grandchildren; Charles Coleman III, Lauren Coleman,
14 Christina Coleman, and Jared Henry; siblings, Raymond Henry
15 (Eugenia) and Brigette Faye Henry-Bennett; sister-in-law,
16 Artha Edna Henry; and dear friend, Ross Malone, Jr.; he was
17 preceded in death by his parents; and

18 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly
19 missed, the memory of Robert Henry will be cherished in the
