21 to an accident; a citizen approached them and informed them of 22 a medical emergency in a vehicle behind them; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Orr positioned his vehicle to block traffic; Deputy Mulkin and Deputy Orr were advised that the man had possibly suffered a heart attack; the deputies removed the man from the car, noticed that he was not breathing, and they could not discern a pulse; they began to render 1 assistance, including CPR, which they continued until 2 paramedics arrived; and

WHEREAS, when the paramedics began treating the man, he had regained his pulse and was breathing; the deputies assisted in clearing traffic so the ambulance could pass more quickly; the 53-year-old man from Murfreesboro, Tennessee, and his family had been travelling to the Gulf beaches for a vacation when this occurred; and

9 WHEREAS, Deputies Mulkin and Orr visited the
10 hospital the next day and learned that the man would not have
11 survived without their efforts; and

12 WHEREAS, Deputy Mulkin received the Sheriff's Office13 Life Saving Medal as a result of this incident; and

14 WHEREAS, Deputy Mulkin's dedicated service
15 contributes greatly to the safety and quality of life of the
16 citizens of Jefferson County, and he is truly deserving of
17 this distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of
18 Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,
