Committee; in 1986 and 1990, he was Chair of the Jefferson
County Senate Delegation; and

WHEREAS, in June 2016, Congressman Hilliard and his wife, Mary, celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary; they have two children, Alesia Hilliard-Smith and Earl Hilliard, Jr., and four grandchildren; he is a Life Member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity and the NAACP; he is also a member of the National Bar Association and the Alabama State Bar Association; and

WHEREAS, an avid civil rights foot soldier, Hilliard worked with voter registration drives and participated in many protest marches; he represented a congressional district that included major cities at the heart of the civil rights movement, including Selma, Montgomery, and Birmingham; and

WHEREAS, his record of excellence and service reflects immense credit upon the entire State of Alabama; the contributions of Congressman Hilliard are numerous and valuable to the citizens of Alabama and he is truly deserving of special recognition; now therefore,
