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8 COMMENDING NATHANIEL GRAYSON MOORE ON ATTAINING THE
9 RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

11 WHEREAS, commendations and congratulations are
12 extended to Nathaniel Grayson Moore of Argo, Alabama, on
13 attaining the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in the Boy
14 Scouts of America; and

15 WHEREAS, Nathan passed the Eagle Scout Board of
16 Review on February 8, 2010, a significant date which is also
17 the 100th Anniversary date for the Boy Scouts of America; he
18 will be recognized in a Court of Honor ceremony on April 10,
19 2010, at CrossPoint, A Southern Baptist Church in Trussville,
20 Alabama; and

21 WHEREAS, the Eagle Scout Award, earned by only a
22 small percentage of Scouts, involves the completion of an
23 Eagle Project and represents many years of diligence in
24 pursuit of a worthy goal that brings honor to the Scout, his
25 family, and his troop; and

26 WHEREAS, a member of Boy Scout Troop 845, Nathan has
27 progressed successfully through the levels of Scouting since

1 joining as a Tiger Cub, winning numerous honors and fulfilling
2 many leadership roles while also meeting the demanding
3 requirements for achieving the Eagle Scout Award; his Eagle
4 Scout service project involved clearing a plot of land owned
5 by the Freshwater Land Trust near the Turkey Creek Nature
6 Preserve in Pinson, ridding the area of two invasive species;

8 WHEREAS, in addition to completing an Eagle Project,
9 an Eagle Scout must earn at least 21 Merit Badges as evidence
10 of mastery in various Scouting skills, and must strive to
11 conduct himself with honor, loyalty, courage, cheer, and
12 service, the five integral responsibilities of a Scout; Nathan
13 has earned 40 Merit Badges in addition to winning the World
14 Conservation Award and completing National Youth Leadership
15 Training; and

16 WHEREAS, the son of Greg and Amanda Moore, Nathan
17 attends the Jefferson County International Baccalaureate
18 program at Shades Valley High School; he is an active member
19 of CrossPoint and has also contributed countless volunteer
20 hours to worthy causes in the community; and

21 WHEREAS, through the years, Nathan has exhibited
22 those hard-won characteristics of trustworthiness,
23 self-discipline, and good citizenship, all components of the
24 Scouting program; with the guidance and support of his
25 Scouting leaders, he has earned the esteem of his community,
26 fellow Scouts, and all Alabamians; now therefore,
