9 ACHIEVEMENT AND AS A DISTINGUISHED 2014 PIONEER AWARDEE.

11 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that Dr.
12 Frederick Carodine, Sr., is commended for his outstanding
13 accomplishments and as a distinguished 2014 Pioneer Awardee;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, a 1951 graduate of Alabama A and M
16 University, he worked in Nashville, Tennessee, for a time
17 before returning to AAMU, and then continued his studies at
18 Cal Poly-San Luis Obispo; and

19 WHEREAS, among his notable accomplishments, he
20 helped establish J.F. Drake State Technical College and worked
21 at the school through the mid-1960s, in addition to operating
22 his own printing shop; and

23 WHEREAS, his impressive career at Redstone Arsenal
24 began with a position in data reduction and analysis; as a
25 GS-7 employee who had to learn the job, he conducted complex
26 positioning space data and recorded statistics from the point

1 of missile launch to target impact, along with data on pitch
2 and altitude; and

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Carodine's numerous civic contributions
4 included playing a key role in the Knight-Sims higher
5 education lawsuit, and he was also active in the Alabama
6 Democratic Conference, Masons, and Rural Senior Services; and

7 WHEREAS, through the years, he has earned respect
8 for his exceptional abilities and tireless dedication, and he
9 is truly deserving of the significant honor bestowed upon him;
10 now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
12 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Dr. Frederick Carodine, Sr.,
13 is most highly honored and commended, and it is directed that
