9	POLICE DEPARTMENT AS A NOMINEE FOR THE 2014 ALABAMA

12	WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
13	recognize Lieutenant C. Oliver of the Montgomery Police
14	Department as a nominee for the 2014 Alabama Legislative Medal
15	of Honor for Law Enforcement, Alabama's highest law
16	enforcement award for extraordinary courage in the line of

18	WHEREAS, Lieutenant Oliver, who held the rank of
19	Sergeant at the time of the event for which he is nominated,
20	was among four officers who responded to a call on August 12,
21	2013, in reference to a suicide attempt; upon arrival, they
22	learned that a man had become irate during a domestic argument
23	and barricaded himself in the attic while threatening to
24	commit suicide; and
25	WHEREAS, the officers were able to gain entry into
26	the residence through a side window, noticed a large knife on
27	the floor, and began to clear the residence in an attempt to

locate the subject, whom they found standing on a dresser with a cable cord around his neck attached to a brace in the attic;

WHEREAS, through a critical span of time, the officers reasoned with the subject, who went through various emotional states from anger to depression to suicide, taking the cord from his neck and then replacing it; at one point, he stepped off the dresser and swung by his neck, appearing to lose and regain consciousness; the officers lifted the subject to relieve the pressure from the cord and desperately began trying to free the cord from the brace despite the actions of the subject; and

WHEREAS, through their quick thinking, diligence, and determination, the officers were finally successful in freeing the subject and were able to save his life; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Oliver and the other officers displayed incredible dedication to their profession by putting themselves in harm's way to save someone's life; the unknown was before them, and they pushed forward without regard to their own safety, and acted in an expedient manner to facilitate the rescue of an individual who most certainly would have perished without their intervention; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Oliver epitomizes the qualities of those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,
