9 ATHLETIC CAREER AND SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY.

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Aundray Bruce is a native of
12 Montgomery, Alabama, and a graduate of G. W. Carver High
13 School in Montgomery, Alabama; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Bruce was an outstanding basketball and
15 football player at Carver High School; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Bruce signed to play football at Auburn
17 University; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Bruce ended his college career as a
19 consensus All-American and a two-time All-SEC pick with his
20 senior statistics being 88 total tackles, 44 solo stops, eight
21 sacks (for minus 48 yards), three interceptions, two tackles
22 for loss (minus 25 yards); and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Bruce became the NFL's top draft pick
24 in the 1988 National Football League draft, becoming, at the
25 time, the third player in Auburn history to go first overall
26 which completed an unforeseen journey to the top; and

1 WHEREAS, in his journey, Mr. Bruce did not forget
2 his family and remained loyal and supportive of his mother,
3 Mrs. Lucille Bruce, and his siblings; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Bruce volunteers his time and talents
5 to various schools and other entities in the City of
6 Montgomery; now therefore,

8 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we do hereby most highly
9 commend and congratulate Mr. Aundray Bruce on his outstanding
