WHEREAS, his legacy endures through the Bill Jones Plaza as part of the Bill Jones Athletic Complex named in honor of his contributions to UNA; and

WHEREAS, through the years, Mr. Jones earned respect for his exceptional abilities and tireless dedication to the highest standards of organized sports, and he is truly deserving of the significant honor bestowed upon him; now therefore,
