11	WHEREAS, highest commendations and congratulations
12	are herein proudly presented to Elder T. Marshall Kelly on his

14	Foundation Pioneer Award; and
15	WHEREAS, Elder T. Marshall Kelly will be recognized
16	at The Rosetta James Foundation's "Honoring Our Elders"
17	Celebration, which is named in honor of an extraordinary
18	native of Akron, Alabama, Mrs. Rosetta James, who has
19	positively impacted countless lives through active citizenship

21	WHEREAS, Elder Kelly is an exemplary bass-baritone
22	singer and composer who has cultivated a distinguished career
23	as an internationally known soloist, ordained minister, radio
24	personality, and award-wining religion teacher in the
25	Seventh-day Adventist church; and
26	WHEREAS, from his earliest years, religion and music
27	have been focal parts of his life; he graduated from Emmanuel

Missionary College, now Andrews University, with a degree in religion in 1952 and served in the Lake Region Conference as a pastor and evangelist and sought-after singer for 25 years; and

WHEREAS, in 1971, he assisted E.E. Cleveland, legendary preacher and evangelist, with the music in a nearly two-month long evangelistic crusade in Australia; E.E. Cleveland described Elder Kelly's devoted work in the crusade in the following way: "the rich velvet voice of T. Marshall Kelly was an indispensable blessing to the success of the campaign; he was accorded the supreme tribute of being rated as 'a second Paul Robeson;" in the following year, the faithful men of God collaborated on another crusade; and

WHEREAS, Elder Kelly made two records, "All That Thrills My Soul" and "It Takes Everything to Serve the Lord," which were released by Chapel Records in the early 1970s; he was invited to speak and sing at a monumental youth rally in Australia in 1976; and

WHEREAS, he established a strong Bible program and assisted in leading a number of faith-based activities at Oakwood College Academy; notably, he received a Zapara Award for Excellence in Teaching in 1990 for his remarkable work as a teacher, counselor, and campus chaplain at the academy; and

WHEREAS, for over 30 years, he has hosted a Sabbath afternoon radio talk show program on WJOU, 90.1 FM; he has released additional recordings including "For Your Encouragement" and Hymns for Him;" and

WHEREAS, he married Garnet Jean Garland a native of 1 2 Cleveland, Ohio, and a graduate of Pine Forge Academy in Pennsylvania in 1952, and they have a son, Eric and a 3 daughter, Nadine; and WHEREAS, Elder Kelly's hard work, ingenuity, and 5 6 civic contributions espouse the meritorious qualities of the 7 Rosetta James Foundation and reflect immense honor upon the entire State of Alabama; he is truly deserving of the 8 significant honor bestowed upon him; now therefore, 9 10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 11 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Elder T.
