22	critical; one point of contact in each county will improve
23	continuity and efficiency; now therefore,
24	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
25	THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the county commission of each
26	county in Alabama is encouraged to appoint a single point of

contact for purposes of communicating and coordinating
broadband issues with ADECA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each county shall notify
ADECA of the name of the county broadband contact within 60
days after the Alabama Broadband Accessibility Act becomes
law.
