9 INTO THE ALABAMA HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS HALL OF FAME.

11 WHEREAS, Moses Knight, Jr., is currently serving as
12 the Athletic Director and Head Basketball Coach at the
13 Abbeville High School in Abbeville, Alabama; and

14 WHEREAS, Coach Knight has coached for 35 years at
15 Abbeville High School; and

16 WHEREAS, currently, he has a record of 838 wins and
17 351 losses; and

18 WHEREAS, he led the Abbeville High School Basketball
19 Team to a second place finish in 1989 and a State 4-A
20 Championship in 1986; and

21 WHEREAS, he missed the state basketball regional
22 playoff only four times during his 35 years of coaching; and

23 WHEREAS, during his tenure as basketball coach, he
24 has produced more than 50 players who have signed basketball
25 scholarships; and

26 WHEREAS, Coach Knight's credo is that, "Most of all
27 it is not about me but the student-athletes I deal with each

1 day at Abbeville High School, what they do on and off court";

3 WHEREAS, indeed, Coach Knight is an exemplar of
4 extraordinary leadership ability and significant achievement;
5 he is entirely deserving of induction into the Alabama High
6 School Sports Hall of Fame; now therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
8 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That in recognition and gratitude
9 for outstanding contributions to athletics, we urge the
10 induction of Coach Moses Knight, Jr., into the Alabama High
11 School Sports Hall Of Fame.
