7 State Veterans Home in Alexander City, Alabama, in 2019; and

9 the CornerStone Church of Christ in Childersburg, Alabama; and

10 WHEREAS, we wish to honor Mr. Ruble Ray Gardner on
11 his 99th Birthday and for his commitment to the United States
12 Government and as a leader in the community, his example as a
13 role model to others, and for his service and dedication to
