worked in the areas of electroacoustics, physical acoustics,

3 WHEREAS, he is a Fellow of Institute of Electrical 4 and Electronics Engineers, a recipient of the George R. 5 Stibitz Trophy, holds over 200 U.S. and foreign patents, was 6 awarded the 2006 National Medal of Technology, and is an 7 advocate for science education, particularly among minority 8 students; and

9 WHEREAS, a leader and an inspiration to many, Mr. 10 West has stated, "Failure is a learning process too often 11 ignored for its true value"; now therefore,
