8 COMMENDING THE "SUPER 11" HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL
9 PLAYERS SELECTED BY THE TUSCALOOSA NEWS FOR OUTSTANDING
10 PERFORMANCE DURING THE 2009 SEASON.

12 WHEREAS, at the end of each high school football
13 season, the Tuscaloosa News selects 11 outstanding high school
14 football players in the Tuscaloosa area in recognition of
15 their superb play during the season; and

16 WHEREAS, the "Super 11" for 2009 consists of the
17 following: James Kelser, a fullback and linebacker for West
18 Blocton who scored 15 touchdowns while recording 72 tackles;
19 Malik Chinn, a linebacker for Tuscaloosa County responsible
20 for 98 tackles; Kendarius Fritts, a running back for Linden
21 who scored 33 touchdowns and was named Class 1A Back of the
22 Year; Quail Rutledge, a running back for Bibb County who
23 scored 42 touchdowns and set a new state record with 286
24 points scored; David Morrison, a wide receiver for Berry named
25 to the Class 1A ALL-STATE team with 15 touchdowns and a record
26 six touchdowns in one game; Lance Wilson, a wide receiver for
27 Hillcrest named to the Class 6A ALL-STATE team with 16

1 touchdowns; Dominique Jones, a running back and wide receiver
2 for Pickens County who totaled 16 touchdowns rushing and
3 receiving; Diaheem Watkins, a defensive end for Bibb County,
4 who recorded 52 tackles with eight and a half sacks; Lance
5 Bobbitt, a linebacker and fullback for Lamar County who
6 recorded 100 tackles and seven touchdowns; Jeremiah Tullidge,
7 a quarterback for Tuscaloosa Academy who passed for 2,777
8 yards and 30 touchdowns; and the West Alabama MVP, Demarcus
9 James, a running back for Demopolis who was named to the Class
10 5A ALL-STATE team after recording a record 293 yards on 42
11 carries while leading his team to a state championship; and

12 WHEREAS, the "Super 11" exemplify the best qualities
13 of West Alabama athletics both on and off the playing field;
14 now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
