10 WHEREAS, Dr. Manuel H. "Manley" Johnson is a native
11 of Troy, Alabama, and a member of the Troy University Class of
12 1973; and

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson has compiled a distinguished
14 record as an internationally recognized economist, serving as
15 vice chair of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve
16 System, Assistant Secretary of the Treasury from 1982-1986,
17 and Deputy Assistant Secretary from 1981-1982; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson is cochair and senior partner
19 in the consulting firm of Johnson Smick International,
20 Incorporated, which provides information services on economic
21 and political policy changes that affect global financial
22 markets; and

23 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson has been a loyal and faithful
24 alumnus of Troy University, serving as chair of the "Building
25 Beyond Boundaries" capital campaign, and as a member of the
26 University Foundation Board of Directors, for which he was
27 recognized with the University's Distinguished Leadership

1 Award in 2010 -- the highest honor the University bestows upon
2 its alumni; and

3 WHEREAS, on Friday, February 10, 2012, Troy
4 University will dedicate in his honor the Johnson Center for
5 Political Economy, which is dedicated to the very best in
6 economic teaching and research; now therefore,
