HR___ MOURNING THE DEATH AND CELEBRATING THE LIFE OF DR.
BOBBY E. HILL.

WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the death of Bobby E. Hill, M.D., of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, on February 23, 2024, at the age of 78; and

WHEREAS, his departure leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the community where he was highly regarded; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hill was born on December 31, 1945, in Bessemer, Alabama, to Clyde Genette and Hannah Lena Hill, both dearly departed; he attended Brighton High School before matriculating to Tennessee State University where he earned his Bachelor of Science degree in 1968; he taught junior and senior high school science in Hale County, Alabama from 1968-1973; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hill returned to Nashville to pursue his M.D. from Meharry Medical College; he completed his Family Medicine residency at The University of Alabama, followed by a brief term as staff physician with the former West Alabama Health Service in Eutaw, Alabama; in 1981, he founded Bobby E. Hill M.D., P.C., a thriving private family medical practice and became the second Black medical doctor to practice in Tuscaloosa; he managed the practice with his wife, Roxie; he also provided medical services for the

30 Facility; his daughter, Dr. Jahana Hill, has assumed
31 management of his practice; and

32 WHEREAS, Dr. Hill was a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
33 Fraternity, Incorporated; he was an avid outdoorsman and
34 enjoyed hunting, fishing, and raising cattle; he was beloved
35 by his family and his patients; and

36 WHEREAS, Dr. Hill will be remembered by his wife,
37 Roxie Hill; children, Dr. Jahana Hill, Iris Hill, and Bobby
38 E. Hill, Jr.; brother, Antony Hill; sister, Maxine Johnson
39 (Alvin); grandson, Noah Ladson; and a host of nieces,
40 nephews, other family, and friends; and

41 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly
42 missed, the memory of Dr. Hill will be cherished in the
43 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore,
