8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. CHARLES SUTTON BRUNSON,

11 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the  
12 death of Charles Sutton Brunson, Jr., on March 20, 2019, at  
13 the age of 93 years; and

14 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of  
15 his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,  
16 where he was highly regarded; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Brunson was born on May 17, 1925, in  
18 Mobile, Alabama, to Charles and Alma Dean Brunson; he was a  
19 graduate of Murphy High School; at the height of World War II,  
20 in September 1943, at the age of 18, he was drafted into the  
21 United States Army Air Corps; he proudly served three years in  
22 New Guinea and the Philipines; and

23 WHEREAS, following his discharge from the United  
24 States Army Air Corps, he completed aircraft training school;  
25 he worked in Civil Service for 40 years and achieved the  
26 position of Director of Quality Assurance with the Navy  
27 Contract Administration Office; he was responsible for

1 ensuring that all U.S. military aircraft in Alabama, Georgia,  
2 and Northwest Florida was properly maintained and repaired;

4 WHEREAS, upon retiring, Mr. Brunson pursued his  
5 passion for painting and writing, and he thoroughly enjoyed  
6 spending time with his grandchildren; and

7 WHEREAS, he was predeceased by his beloved wife of  
8 70 years, Janice Wilkins Brunson; his parents; and three  
9 siblings, Elizabeth Brunson White, Calvin Brunson and Loraine  
10 Brunson North; his survivors include his two children, Charles  
11 Michael Brunson (Kathy) and Lisa Brunson MacCaffrey (Douglas);  
12 six grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; and a host of  
13 other relatives and many friends; and

14 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly  
15 missed, the memory of Mr. Brunson will be cherished in the  
16 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore,
