8 SYNOPSIS: Under current law, boat trailers are not
9 required to be registered or have a license plate
10 within the State of Alabama. Manufacturers and
11 dealers of boats within the state that sell and
12 transport boats out of the state run the risk of
13 fines and traffic citations without proper

documentation.

This bill would allow manufacturers and dealers of boats located within the State of Alabama to make application to the Department of Revenue for the authority to issue temporary license plates and registration certificates for boat trailers when sold out of state. This would also include the manufacturers and dealers of other types of trailers to include semi-trailers and utility trailers, to issue temporary license plates and registration certificates when conducting out of state sales.

In addition, it would standardize the bond requirements for all manufacturers and dealers of

house trailers, semitrailers or trailers, including utility trailers, manufactured by it in this state and which are to be permanently licensed in some state other than Alabama. A dealer in mobile homes, trailer coaches, travel trailers, or house trailers, semitrailers or trailers, including utility trailers, may also make application to the department for authority to issue temporary license tags plates and temporary registration certificates in connection with such vehicles sold by it which are to be permanently licensed in some state other than the State of Alabama. If approved by the department, such manufacturer or dealer shall enter into a bond with a corporate surety authorized to do business in this state as surety thereon, payable to the State of Alabama in a sum to be determined by the department, but in no event less than \$5,000.00, conditioned on the faithful performance of its duties under this division. In lieu of such bond, such manufacturer or dealer may file a condensed balance sheet as of a date not more than three months prior to July 1 each year in a form prescribed by the department and sworn to by such manufacturer or dealer, evidencing a net worth of not less than \$25,000.00. Such manufacturer or dealer may perform its duties under this division either personally or through any of its officers or employees. Temporary license tags issued by any such manufacturer or dealer or by designated agents in connection with mobile homes, trailer coaches, travel trailers, and house trailers shall be of a color or design

distinctive from the temporary license tags issued for other type motor vehicles.

manufacturing, constructing, or assembling plant in this state may make application to the department for authority to issue a temporary license plate and temporary registration certificate in connection with the boat trailer used to transport such boat manufactured by it in this state when the boat is to be domiciled in some state other than Alabama. A dealer in boats may also make application to the department for authority to issue temporary license plates and temporary registration certificates in connection with a boat trailer used to transport a boat sold by it which is to be permanently domiciled in some state other than the State of Alabama.

"(c) If approved by the department, such manufacturer or dealer shall enter into a bond with a corporate surety authorized to do business in this state as surety thereon, payable to the State of Alabama in a sum as provided for in Section 40-12-398, Code of Alabama 1975.

Provided that a manufacturer or dealer who has entered into a bond pursuant to Section 32-8-34, 32-20-22, or 40-12-398, Code of Alabama 1975, shall not be required to obtain another bond pursuant to this section. Such manufacturer or dealer may perform its duties under this division either personally or through any of its officers or employees."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
