BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Alabama Council of Chapters Military Officers Association of America, and its affiliated
local chapters, located in Alabama are exempted from paying or
collecting any state, county, and municipal sales and use
taxes.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
