25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 2 of Act 2017-131 of the 2017
27	Regular Session is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. This act shall apply to any defendant 1 2 who is charged with capital murder after the effective date of this act and shall not apply retroactively to any defendant 3 who has previously been convicted of capital murder and 4 5 sentenced to death prior to the effective date of this act. Any defendant sentenced to death by the court after the jury 7 returned a verdict of life without parole shall be resentenced to life without parole in accordance with this act." 8 Section 2. This act shall become effective 9 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 11
