- 30 (b) Persons permitted to operate community water 31 systems shall assess the environmental fee imposed by 32 subsection (a) on all customers and remit the sum to the 33 Department of Revenue quarterly. The remittance shall be due by the 20th day of the month following the last month of the 34 35 quarter in which the fee was levied. The operator shall 36 certify to the Department of Revenue the number of customers 37 served by their community water system in a manner prescribed by the department. Operators may retain three cents (\$0.03) 38
- (c) The Department of Revenue shall transfer all funds

  collected pursuant to this section each quarter, less its

  administrative collection allowance, into the Alabama

  Revenue may offset the cost of administration from the

  proceeds of the environmental fee levied under this section.

- Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
