(b) No individual, firm, corporation, association, or educational institution shall interfere with or restrict in any manner the ability of media organizations to cover, in any form or format, sporting events involving public K-12 schools, and public K-12 schools shall allow media organizations and their personnel reasonable access to those events.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
