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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
6 existence and functioning of the State Radiation Control
7 Agency with certain modifications; to remove the agency from
8 review by the Alabama Sunset Committee and to repeal Section
9 22-14-5, Code of Alabama 1975, which establishes the Radiation
10 Advisory Board of Health.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
13 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State
14 Radiation Control Agency, with the additional recommendation
15 for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

16 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
17 State Radiation Control Agency, created and functioning
18 pursuant to Sections 22-14-1 to 22-14-4, inclusive, 22-14-6 to
19 22-14-35, inclusive, and 22-32-4 to 22-32-8, inclusive, Code
20 of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections are
21 expressly preserved.

22 Section 3. Commencing on the effective date of this
23 act, the State Radiation Control Agency is no longer an
24 enumerated agency subject to review by the Alabama Sunset
25 Committee.

1 Section 4. Section 22-14-5, Code of Alabama 1975,
2 establishing the Radiation Advisory Board of Health, is
3 repealed.

4 Section 5. The Legislature concurs in the
5 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
6 Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4.

7 Section 6. This act shall become effective
8 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
9 its otherwise becoming law.
