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20	To amend Section 7 of Act 2010-726 of the 2010
21	Regular Session, now appearing as Section 36-21-186, Code of
22	Alabama 1975, relating to a voluntary contribution by ad
23	valorem taxpayers on a checkoff of annual tax statements for
24	the Alabama Firefighters Annuity and Benefit Fund; to provide
25	for a voluntary contribution to the fund made by checkoff on
26	the annual income tax returns.
27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1	Section 1. Section 7 of Act 2010-726 of the 2010
2	Regular Session, now appearing as Section 36-21-186 of the
3	Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:
4	"§36-21-186.
5	"(a) In order to fund this article, an <u>a minimum</u>
6	annual fee of two dollars (\$2) may be voluntarily contributed
7	by indicating on a check-off box which shall be provided on
8	annual ad valorem tax statements or a document provided with
9	the annual ad valorem tax statement that is prescribed by the
10	person or authority administering the program and agreed to by
11	the executive director. from either or both the income tax
12	return of the contributor and the annual ad valorem statement
13	of the contributor by indicating on a check-off box which
14	shall be provided. The checkoff shall be described as the
15	"Alabama Firefighters Annuity and Benefit Fund." If a taxpayer
16	voluntarily indicates, two dollars (\$2) <u>or more</u> shall be added
17	to his or her <u>income tax</u> amount due <u>or his or her property tax</u>
18	due, or both, respectively, and shall be paid to the
19	appropriate person or authority administering the program. The
20	voluntary contribution or contributions made by the taxpayer
21	shall be distributed by the appropriate person or authority
22	administering the program to the fund created by this article.
23	"(b) The <u>net</u> amount of all such fees shall be

remitted by the person or authority collecting the same to the executive director on the tenth day of each month next succeeding that in which the fee is paid." Section 2. (a) Each Alabama state individual income
 tax return form for the 2010 tax year and each year thereafter
 shall contain a designation as follows:

4 "Alabama Firefighters Annuity and Benefit Fund.
5 "Check () if you wish to designate \$2 or more of
6 your state income tax refund.

7 "If joint return, check () if spouse wishes to
8 designate \$2 or more."

9 (b) Each individual taxpayer required to file a 10 state income tax return desiring to contribute to the Alabama 11 Firefighters Annuity and Benefit Fund, may designate, by 12 placing an "X" in the appropriate box on the state income tax 13 form, that such contribution shall be credited to the 14 foundation.

(c) The Department of Revenue shall determine annually the total amount designated pursuant to subsection (b) for the fund and shall deposit such amount, less costs of administration not to exceed three percent of revenue produced, to the fund.

20 (d) The commissioner of the department is authorized
21 to prescribe and implement such forms, rules, and regulations
22 as shall be necessary to carry out the intent of this section.
23 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
24 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
