20	blood in a voluntary and noncompensatory blood donation
21	program if the person obtains written permission from the
22	person's parent or guardian.
23	"(c) A person 18 years of age or older may consent
24	to donate blood or plasma without the permission of a parent

1	or guardian. The consent is not subject to later disaffirmance
2	because of minority."
3	Section 2. Section 26-1-3, Code of Alabama 1975, is
4	repealed.
5	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
6	first day of the third month following its passage and
7	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
