1 AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Department of Homeland Security; to allow the Alabama Department of Homeland Security to hire police officers and special agents; to give the department, its officers, and special agents the ability to enforce the laws of this state; to make the officers and special agents subject to the same benefits, compensation, and standards and training as officers and special agents under the Department of Public Safety; and to give the Director of the Alabama Department of Homeland Security the authority to promulgate rules to implement this act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Security may hire, appoint, and maintain APOST certified state police officers and special agents to assist with the implementation and enforcement of the laws of this state and to fulfill the mission of the Alabama Department of Homeland Security.

(b) The Alabama Department of Homeland Security, its officers, and special agents shall have the same powers and authority and receive the same benefits and compensation as those prescribed to officers and special agents employed by the Alabama Department of Public Safety under Chapter 2 of Title 32 of the Code of Alabama 1975. Any conflicting provisions in Section 31-9A-9, Code of Alabama 1975, are hereby repealed.

- 1 (c) The officers and special agents shall be subject
 2 to the same Peace Officers' Standards and Training as those
 3 prescribed to officers and special agents employed by the
 4 Alabama Department of Public Safety under Article 3 of Chapter
 5 21 of Title 36 of the Code of Alabama 1975.
 - (d) The Director of the Alabama Department of Homeland Security may promulgate rules necessary for the implementation of this act.

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 10 first day of the third month following its passage and 11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
