1 Enrolled, An Act,

4 Relating to criminal procedure; to further provide for  
5 pretrial supervision of certain offenders by the Board of  
6 Pardons and Paroles as a condition of their bond.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law, a  
9 judge may order, as a condition of bond, that a defendant  
10 charged with any offense listed in Section 15-13-3, Code of  
11 Alabama 1975, be supervised by the Board of Pardons and  
12 Paroles

13 (b) The board shall adopt rules necessary to implement  
14 the requirements of this act.

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
16 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
17 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law, and shall be  
18 operative upon certification by the Director of Finance that  
19 sufficient funds have been appropriated to the Board of  
20 Pardons and Paroles to implement this act.
