1 Enrolled, An Act,

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4 Relating to municipal gas districts incorporated by two
5 or more municipalities; to amend Section 11-50-393 of the Code
6 of Alabama 1975, to increase the amount of the director's fees
7 authorized to be paid, at the discretion of the board, to the
8 members of the board of directors and the chair for each
9 meeting of the board.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 11-50-393 of the Code of Alabama
12 1975, is amended to read as follows:

13 "§11-50-393

14 Each district incorporated under this article shall
15 have a board of directors of not less than three members, and
16 the members shall elect a ~~chairman~~ chair of the board. Unless
17 otherwise provided in the certificate of incorporation, the
18 board of directors shall consist of at least one member for
19 each municipality which is a member of the district. Unless
20 otherwise provided in the certificate of incorporation, the
21 member of the board of directors representing each member
22 municipality shall be elected by the governing body of each
23 municipality and shall serve for a term of office concurrent
24 with the term of office of the mayor of the municipality. A
25 representative of each municipality may be, but need not be,
26 the mayor thereof. The members of the board of directors shall
27 serve without compensation, except that they shall be
28 reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the performance of



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29 their duties under this article, and, at the discretion of the
30 board of directors, they may be paid a director's fee not
31 exceeding ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ one thousand seven
32 hundred fifty dollars (\$1,750) for each director's meeting
33 attended, but not to exceed one meeting each calendar month.
34 The ~~chairman~~ chair of the board of directors shall serve
35 without compensation, except that he or she shall be
36 reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the performance of
37 his or her duties under this article, and, at the discretion
38 of the board of directors, he or she may be paid a director's
39 fee not exceeding ~~one thousand two hundred fifty dollars~~
40 ~~(\$1,250)~~ two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each director's
41 meeting attended, but not to exceed one meeting each calendar
42 month. Members of the board of directors shall hold office
43 until their successors are appointed and qualify. Appointments
44 to fill a vacancy shall be for the unexpired term. The
45 appointing authority may remove any member of the board of
46 directors within the term for which he or she is appointed
47 after giving the member a copy of the charges against him or
48 her and an opportunity to be heard in his or her defense. The
49 removal action of the appointing authority shall be final and
50 nonreviewable."

51 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
52 1, 2024.
