8 TO BE ENTITLED
9 AN ACT

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11 To amend Section 34-7B-13, Code of Alabama 1975, as
12 created by Act 2013-371, 2013 Regular Session, to exempt any
13 person who has been practicing as a barber for at least 10
14 years on or prior to August 1, 2013.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. Section 34-7B-13 of the Code of Alabama
17 1975, as created by Act 2013-371, 2013 Regular Session, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 "§34-7B-13.

20 "This chapter does not apply to any of the following
21 persons, activities, or services:

22 "(1) Service in the case of emergency or domestic
23 upheaval, without compensation.

24 "(2) Licensed medical professionals operating within
25 the scope of their normal practice.

26 "(3) Personnel of the United States armed services
27 performing their ordinary duties.

1 "(4) Any public trade school or other public school
2 or school program under the purview of the State Board of
3 Education or a local board of education.

4 "(5) Any person who only occasionally dresses hair
5 and receives no compensation therefor, or does any other act
6 or thing mentioned in this chapter, without holding himself or
7 herself out to the public as a provider of any practices
8 defined in this chapter for compensation.

9 "(6) Departments in retail establishments where
10 cosmetics are demonstrated and offered for sale but where no
11 other acts of cosmetology or barbering are performed.

12 "(7) The licensees of any county or municipal barber
13 board or commission in existence on August 1, 2013, unless
14 such board or commission elects, by resolution adopted by the
15 governing body of the county or municipality, to come under
16 the provisions of this chapter.

17 "(8) Any person who has been practicing as a barber,
18 as that term is commonly used, for at least 10 years on or
19 before August 1, 2013. For purposes of this subdivision, the
20 definitions of the terms "barber" and "barbering" in Section
21 34-7B-1 shall not apply."

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
23 first day of the third month following its passage and
24 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
