4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to motor vehicles; to provide for the
6 issuance of a distinctive motorcycle license plate for breast
7 cancer research under certain conditions; to provide for an
8 additional annual fee; to provide for the distribution of the
9 net proceeds; and to provide for the design.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of
12 Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, upon application to the
13 judge of probate, license commissioner, or other issuing
14 official, compliance with motor vehicle registration and
15 licensing laws, payment of regular fees required by law for
16 motorcycle license tags or plates, and payment of an annual
17 additional fee of fifty dollars (\$50), owners of motorcycles
18 who are residents of Alabama shall be issued distinctive
19 "Breast Cancer Research" motorcycle license tags or plates.
20 The motorcycle tags or plates shall be numbered or
21 personalized. These tags or plates shall be valid for five
22 years and may then be replaced with either conventional,
23 personalized, or new "Breast Cancer Research" motorcycle tags
24 or plates. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the
25 motorcycle tags or plates shall only be printed and issued as

1 long as the Breast Cancer Research Foundation of Alabama
2 qualifies for a distinctive license plate category pursuant to
3 Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, for passenger cars,
4 pickup trucks, and self-propelled campers or house cars.

5 (b) Payment of required license fees and taxes for
6 the years during which a new tag or plate is not issued shall
7 be evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63, Code of Alabama
8 1975.

9 (c) The Breast Cancer Research Foundation of Alabama
10 shall be responsible for the design of the distinctive
11 motorcycle license plate subject to approval by the
12 Commissioner of Revenue and compliance with all laws and
13 regulations.

14 (d) The annual additional fee for the motorcycle
15 plates shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions
16 of Section 32-6-68, Code of Alabama 1975. The Breast Cancer
17 Research Foundation of Alabama portion of the fee shall be
18 used to provide funding for breast cancer research in the
19 State of Alabama.

20 (e) The Department of Revenue may promulgate rules
21 to implement this section.

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective on
23 January 1, 2014.
