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6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to the City of Anniston, Alabama;
8 authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages within the city
9 limits each day of the week by properly licensed clubs and
10 retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and
11 to provide for the off-premises sale of alcoholic beverages;
12 to authorize the governing body of the city to regulate the
13 selling of alcoholic beverages to the general public by
14 properly licensed retailers.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. This act only applies to the City of
17 Anniston and provides for the Anniston Ecotourism Beverage
18 Bill.

19 Section 2. Alcoholic beverages may be sold each day
20 of the week for on-premises consumption by licensed clubs and
21 retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in
22 the City of Anniston if approved by a majority vote of the
23 governing body.

24 Section 3. Alcoholic beverages may be sold each day
25 of the week for off-premises consumption by licensed clubs and

1 retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board
2 within the City of Anniston if approved by a majority vote of
3 the governing body.

4 Section 4. The governing body of the City of
5 Anniston, by resolution or ordinance passed by a simple
6 majority, may regulate but may not prohibit the sale of both
7 on-premises and off-premises consumption of alcoholic
8 beverages each day of the week by licensed clubs and retail
9 licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to the
10 general public. Licensed clubs and retail licensees granted a
11 license may sell or dispense alcoholic beverages pursuant to
12 the requirements of the license and applicable regulations of
13 the board.

14 Section 5. The provisions of this act are cumulative
15 and supplemental to the present power and authority of the
16 City of Anniston and are not intended to, nor shall it be
17 interpreted so as to, repeal any existing power or authority
18 of the governing body with this act that are now permitted
19 under the general laws of the state or under any local or
20 special act of the Legislature.

21 Section 6. This act shall become effective
22 immediately following its passage and approval by the
23 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
