| 7 | AN ACT |
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| 9 | Relating to virtual education; to authorize full-time |
| 10 | students to complete state required assessments through closed |
| 11 | browser remote testing; to specify the conditions for |
| 12 | administering the assessments; and to exempt public |
| 13 | institutions of higher education. |
| 14 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: |
| 15 | Section 1. (a) Commencing with the 2025-2026 school |
| 16 | year, and subject to the availability of funds, any virtual |
| 17 | school or program operating in this state may administer state |
| 18 | required assessments in a virtual setting that aligns with the |
| 19 | regular academic instruction of the student, subject to all of |
| 20 | the following conditions: |
| 21 | (1) The assessment is administered to the student on an |
| 22 | assigned date and at an assigned time. |
| 23 | (2) The student attends a synchronous assessment |
| 24 | session initiated and managed by personnel designated by the |
| 25 | virtual school or program. |
| 26 | (3) The assessment is administered to the student |
| 27 | through a device that permits the assessment proctor to |
| 28 | monitor the student by video for the entire duration of the |



29 assessment administration.

30 (4) If the assessment platform does not allow 31 integrated camera proctoring, the student uses two devices for 32 the entire duration of the assessment administration: One 33 device on which the student takes the assessment and a second 34 device which allows the assessment proctor to monitor the 35 student via a camera. If the assessment platform allows for 36 the assessment proctor to view the student and background, a 37 second device is not required.

38 (5) The virtual school or program maintains a student 39 assessment taker to assessment proctor ratio of 10 to one or 40 lower.

41 (6) The student does not exit the assessment
42 administration area until instructed to do so by the assigned
43 assessment proctor.

44 (7) Submission of the assessment is verified by the45 assessment proctor.

46 (b) This section shall not apply to either of the 47 following:

48 (1) Public institutions of higher education.

49 (2) College readiness or workforce readiness
50 assessments provided by a national college and career
51 readiness assessment provider until those assessments are
52 available via remote access.

(c) Any individual who administers an assessment or serves as an assessment proctor pursuant to this section shall be a teacher who holds a valid Alabama professional education certificate.
