11 Relating to motor vehicle registrations; to allow a  
12 county official authorized to issue motor vehicle  
13 registrations to offer an optional two-year registration for  
14 motor vehicles operated on the public highways of this state;  
15 to specify the payment of local issuance fees, license taxes  
16 and registration fees, and ad valorem taxes.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the  
19 local judge of probate or other county license plate issuing  
20 official authorized to issue motor vehicle licenses or  
21 registrations may offer an optional two-year license and  
22 registration for motor vehicles operated on the public  
23 highways of this state.

24 (b) If a registrant elects to register his or her  
25 motor vehicle for a two-year period, he or she shall do all of  
26 the following:

1                   (1) Pay the local issuance fee. The registrant shall  
2 not be required to pay an additional local issuance fee for  
3 the second year of registration.

4                   (2) Pay the license taxes, ad valorem tax, and  
5 registration fees for each year at the time of the election to  
6 renew the registration for two years.

7                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
8 first day of the third month following its passage and  
9 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
