9 (b) Notwithstanding any other laws to the contrary, 10 the funds appropriated to the Department of Education by 11 subsection (a) of this section shall not be expended without 12 prior approval of the State Superintendent of Education.

13 (c)(1) The above appropriation for teacher 14 professional development shall be allocated to the Alabama 15 Department of Education to be distributed to the Ed Farm Classroom of Tomorrow. These funds will be used by Ed Farm to 16 17 provide technology tools and professional development services to classroom teachers in an effort to improve instruction and 18 19 student learning gains. It is the intent of the legislature 20 that in addition to general programmatic costs, Ed Farm may 21 also expend funds for software, hardware, administrative costs and professional learning services. 22

(2) The State Superintendent shall provide a report
of the initiative to the Chair of the House Ways and

Means-Education Committee and the Chair of the Senate
 Committee on Finance and Taxation-Education no later than
 October 1, 2022

4 Section 4. All funds not expended in the current 5 fiscal year shall not revert but be carried forward for the 6 purpose appropriated.

Section 5. This act shall become effective
immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
upon its otherwise becoming law.
