Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations 8 9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 10 \$3,112,615 from the Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September 11 30, 2019. Of this appropriation, \$1,809,535 shall be expended 12 13 for start-up costs incurred in connection with the implementation of a new Student Administration System; 14 15 \$303,080 shall be expended for pilot projects to address dyslexia; and \$1,000,000 shall be expended to support the 16 17 development of programs specifically targeted at literacy, 18 numeracy, and career and technical education through the expansion of professional development opportunities for 19 20 teachers in the summer of 2019.

21 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations 22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 23 \$1,550,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of 24 Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year ending September 25 30, 2019. Of this appropriation, \$1,300,000 shall be expended 26 for the Early Intervention Program and \$250,000 shall be 1 transferred to the Alabama Head and Spinal Cord Injury Trust
2 Fund.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
\$500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Public
Library Service for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.
Of this appropriation, \$250,000 shall be distributed to the
Alabama Supreme Court Library and \$250,000 is to be
distributed to public libraries within the State.

10 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated up 11 to \$650,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama 12 13 Building Renovation Finance Authority for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019. This appropriation shall be 14 15 expended to reimburse the Authority for expenditures incurred related to bicentennial activities. This appropriation shall 16 17 be limited to the amount necessary to reimburse the Authority.

18 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations 19 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 20 \$150,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Lieutenant 21 Governor Workforce Commission for the fiscal year ending 22 September 30, 2019.

23 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations 24 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 25 \$977,997 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama 26 Community College System for the Dual Enrollment Program for 27 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.

Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$570,000 from the Alabama Board of Nursing Trust Fund to the Alabama Board of Nursing for necessary internal server upgrades for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.

6 Section 8. This act shall become effective 7 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 8 upon its otherwise becoming law.
