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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To repeal and reenact Section 16-3-1.1, Code of
6 Alabama 1975, to provide for the reapportionment and
7 redistricting of the State Board of Education districts based
8 on the 2020 federal census.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Section 16-3-1.1, Code of Alabama 1975,
11 relating to the existing State Board of Education districts,
12 is repealed.

13 Section 2. Section 16-3-1.1, is added to the Code of
14 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

15 §16-3-1.1.

16 (a) The State of Alabama is divided into eight State
17 Board of Education districts as provided in subsection (b).

18 (b) The numbers and boundaries of the districts are
19 designated and established by the map prepared by the
20 Permanent Legislative Committee on Reapportionment and
21 identified and labeled as the McClendon SBOE Plan 1, including
22 the corresponding boundary description provided by the census
23 tracts, blocks, and counties, and are incorporated by
24 reference as part of this section.

1 (c) The Legislature shall post for viewing on its
2 public website the map referenced in subsection (b), including
3 the corresponding boundary description provided by the census
4 tracts, blocks, and counties, and any alternative map,
5 including the corresponding boundary description provided by
6 the census tracts, blocks, and counties, introduced by any
7 member of the Legislature during the legislative session in
8 which this section is added or amended.

9 (d) Upon enactment of the act adding this section
10 and adopting the map identified in subsection (b), the Clerk
11 of the House of Representatives or the Secretary of the
12 Senate, as appropriate, shall transmit the map and the
13 corresponding boundary description provided by the census
14 tracts, blocks, and counties identified in subsection (b) for
15 certification and posting on the public website of the
16 Secretary of State.

17 (e) The boundary descriptions provided by the
18 certified map referenced in subsection (b) shall prevail over
19 the boundary descriptions provided by the census tracts,
20 blocks, and counties generated for the map.

21 Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable.
22 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
23 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
24 which remains.

1 Section 4. This act shall become effective
2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
3 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
