125924-2:n:03/09/2011:KMS/th LRS2011-557R1 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Alabama Board of 8 Nursing awards graduate degree scholarships for 9 10 nurses of \$3,800 per year to those who qualify and 11 agree to practice nursing in Alabama for one year. 12 This bill would increase the amount of the 13 scholarship awards to \$10,000 and would award scholarships equal to five percent of those 14 15 enrolled in graduate nursing programs in Alabama. 16 This bill would require applicants to have 17 an Alabama professional nursing license and agree 18 to practice nursing in Alabama for two years. 19 This bill would give preference to 20 applicants pursuing a career in nursing education. 21 This bill would provide that any 22 appropriation to fund the scholarships be made 23 through the Education Trust Fund. 24 25 A BILL 26 TO BE ENTITLED 27 AN ACT

To amend Sections 34-21-60, 34-21-61, 34-21-62, and 2 34-21-63, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to graduate degree 3 4 scholarships for nurses; to increase the amount of such 5 scholarships; to require applicants to meet additional 6 qualifications; and to require any appropriation to fund the 7 scholarships be made through the Education Trust Fund. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 8 Section 1. Sections 34-21-60, 34-21-61, 34-21-62, 9 10 and 34-21-63 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read 11 as follows: 12 "§34-21-60. 13 "There shall be established for the fiscal year 14 ending September 30, 1978, 15 2011, scholarships for 15 post-baccalaureate graduate education of nurses. These scholarships shall be awarded to applicants from the State of 16 17 Alabama at large. They shall be distributed, insofar as practicable, throughout the state. The number of scholarships 18 shall equal five percent of the total enrollment in graduate 19 nursing programs in Alabama. Each scholarship is limited to 20 21 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). 22 "§34-21-61. 23 "(a) To be eligible to receive a scholarship 24 provided by this article, a person must have been an applicant 25 shall satisfy all of the following requirements:

"<u>(1) Be</u> a resident of the State of Alabama for a
 period of at least one year immediately preceding the time of
 making application, must be.

4 "<u>(2) Be</u> a person of good character and shall have 5 been.

6 "<u>(3) Have an active, unencumbered license as a</u> 7 professional nurse in Alabama.

8 "<u>(4) Be</u> accepted for matriculation in a <u>an Alabama</u> 9 graduate nursing program conducted by an accredited school of 10 nursing, must hold a baccalaureate degree in nursing from an 11 accredited nursing school and must agree <u>college or</u> 12 university.

"(5) Agree to practice professional nursing in the
State of Alabama for at least one year two years after
completing the course in graduate study degree.

16 "(b) Preference shall be given to applicants pursing 17 <u>a career in nursing education.</u>

"(c) These scholarships will shall be available to 18 students applicants seeking master's or doctorate degrees in 19 nursing. Doctorate degrees in education are also acceptable 20 21 provided the applicant holds a graduate degree in nursing. 22 "(d) Application for these scholarships shall be made to the Alabama Board of Nursing. The Board of Nursing 23 24 shall receive five percent of the total appropriation to 25 administer the scholarships.

"Each scholarship provided for by this article shall 1 2 be in the amount of \$3,800 not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per year, payable from funds appropriated to the 3 4 Alabama Board of Nursing for this purpose. Contingent upon subsequent legislative funding of this program, a scholarship 5 6 may either be renewed by the Alabama Board of Nursing for the 7 same student or awarded to another applicant for the scholarship. Criteria for the selection of recipients and 8 9 awarding of the scholarships shall be established by the 10 Alabama Board of Nursing. These criteria shall be used as guides in the selection of the scholarship recipients from the 11 12 various geographical areas of the state. In case a scholarship 13 student fails to complete the course prescribed for a graduate 14 degree in nursing, that student shall repay the amount of any scholarship funds received hereunder to the State Treasury. In 15 the event of the scholarship recipient's death, the obligation 16 17 for funds disbursed and not repaid shall be cancelled. In the event the scholarship recipient becomes mentally or physically 18 impaired and is unable to complete a graduate course in 19 20 nursing, or has received a graduate degree but is unable to 21 complete one year of service as a nurse due to such 22 disability, the obligation for funds disbursed and not repaid 23 shall be cancelled.

25 "There is hereby appropriated each year, beginning
 26 with the fiscal year ending September 30, 1978, to the Alabama
 27 Board of Nursing, out of any funds in the State Treasury to

the credit of the Education Trust Fund, the sum of \$57,000, to 1 2 be used solely for funding scholarships provided by this article. The Any appropriation provided in this section is in 3 4 addition to any appropriations heretofore made, or to fund the scholarships shall be made, through the Education Trust Fund 5 to the Alabama Board of Nursing for each fiscal year." 6 7 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the 8

9 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
