5 Relating to the State Board of Chiropractic
6 Examiners; to add Section 34-24-146 to the Code of Alabama
7 1975, to authorize the board to set reasonable fees by rule of
8 the board for certain services provided by the board.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Section 34-24-146 is added to the Code of
11 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

12 §34-24-146.

13 The state Board of Chiropractic Examiners, by rule
14 of the board, may set, charge, and collect reasonable fees for
15 services provided by the board, including, but not limited to,
16 the following services:

17 (1) Applications for approval of continuing
18 education seminars.

19 (2) Verification of licensure status of licensees.

20 (3) Copies of records provided by the board.

21 (4) Other services as determined necessary by the
22 board to reimburse the board for expenses reasonably related
23 to the delivery of the services.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
