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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To make a supplemental appropriation from the
6 Enforcement Seizure Fund to the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage
7 Control Board in the amount of \$750,000 for the fiscal year
8 ending September 30, 2014; to make a supplemental
9 appropriation from the Music Hall of Fame Fund to the Alabama
10 Music Hall of Fame Board in the amount of \$80,000 for the
11 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to require a transfer
12 of \$50,000 from the ABC Board Fund of the Alabama Alcoholic
13 Beverage Control Board to the State General Fund for the
14 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to make a supplemental
15 appropriation of \$50,000 from the State General Fund to the
16 Court of Civil Appeals for the fiscal year ending September
17 30, 2014; to make a supplemental appropriation of \$25,300 from
18 the Forfeited Assets Fund to the Department of Forensic
19 Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to
20 require a transfer of \$125,000 from the Departmental Emergency
21 Fund to the Alabama Job Creation and Military Stability
22 Commission, as established pursuant to Act 2011-350, for the
23 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to require a transfer
24 from the Departmental Emergency Fund and appropriation to the
25 Alabama Job Creation and Military Stability Commission, as

1 established pursuant to Act 2011-350, in the amount of
2 \$125,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to
3 require a transfer of \$1,500,000 from the Office of the
4 Attorney General to the Office of Prosecution Services for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; and to amend
6 appropriations made in Section 2C of Act 2013-263 for the
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
10 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
11 \$750,000 from the Enforcement Seizure Fund to the Alabama
12 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the fiscal year ending
13 September 30, 2014.

14 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
15 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
16 \$80,000 from the Music Hall of Fame Fund to the Alabama Music
17 Hall of Fame Board for the fiscal year ending September 30,
18 2014.

19 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage
21 Control Board shall transfer \$50,000 from the ABC Board Fund
22 to the State General Fund for the fiscal year ending September
23 30, 2014.

24 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
25 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

1 \$50,000 from the State General Fund to the Court of Civil
2 Appeals for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

3 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$25,300 from the Forfeited Assets Fund to the Department of
6 Forensic Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30,
7 2014.

8 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there shall be transferred from
10 the Departmental Emergency Fund provided for in Section
11 41-4-94, Code of Alabama 1975, and appropriated to the Alabama
12 Job Creation and Military Stability Commission, as established
13 pursuant to Act 2011-350, the amount of \$125,000 for the
14 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

15 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
16 heretofore or hereafter made, the Office of the Attorney
17 General shall transfer \$1,500,000 to the Office of Prosecution
18 Services from the funds received pursuant to the National
19 Mortgage Settlement for the fiscal year ending September 30,
20 2014.

21 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
22 heretofore or hereafter made, \$1,500,000 of the appropriation
23 made within the Court Operations Program of the Office of
24 Prosecution Services in Section 2C of Act 2013-263 shall
25 consist of a transfer from the Office of the Attorney General

1 from funds received from the National Mortgage Settlement.
2 This appropriation shall be distributed to the District
3 Attorney's Office in each Judicial Circuit in proportion to
4 the State General Fund allocations to those offices made in
5 Act 2013-263. This appropriation must be used for costs of
6 investigation and litigation of law enforcement efforts to
7 prevent and prosecute financial fraud and/or for public
8 protection services.

9 Section 9. This act shall become effective
10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
11 upon its otherwise becoming law.
