19	To provide for the zoning authority of
20	municipalities in this state incorporated after 1990 located
21	in a county in which another municipality in the county has
22	zoning authority in its police jurisdiction.
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. This act shall apply to all
25	municipalities in this state incorporated after 1990 which are
26	located in a county in which another municipality in that
27	county has zoning authority in its police jurisdiction.

Section 2. (a) Any municipality in this state incorporated after 1990, which is located in a county in which another municipality in that county has zoning authority in its police jurisdiction, may divide the territory within its police jurisdiction into business, industrial, and residential zones or districts and, at its option, may provide the kind, character, and use of structures and improvements that may be erected or made within the several zones or districts established and, from time to time, may rearrange or alter the boundaries of the zones or districts and may also adopt ordinances as are necessary to implement and administer this act. It is the intent of this act to grant any municipality to which this act applies full zoning authority within its police jurisdiction to the same extent as the municipality exercises that authority within its corporate limits.

(b) This act shall not affect the right of the owner or owners of property located within the police jurisdiction of a municipality to which this act applies to continue to use the property as it is being used on the date of the enactment of any zoning ordinance applicable to the property until the owner or owners of the property seek to change the use of the property.

Section 3. In the event the police jurisdiction of any municipality to which this act applies overlaps with the police jurisdiction of another municipality in the county that has zoning authority in its police jurisdiction, the governing body of each municipality may exercise the zoning authority in

the overlapping portions of its police jurisdiction to a
boundary which is equidistant from the respective corporate
limits of each municipality that has an overlapping police
jurisdiction. Nothing in this section prevents neighboring
municipalities from entering into cooperative agreements as to
which municipality will exercise zoning authority in the areas

of overlapping police jurisdiction.

Section 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3, in the overlapping areas of the police jurisdiction of the municipalities, each municipality may object to a zoning decision of the other municipality in the overlapping areas. In that case, the objecting municipality shall notify the other municipality of its objection and the zoning dispute shall be resolved by a panel consisting of the mayors of the two municipalities and the chair of the county commission of the county where the property involved in the zoning dispute is located.

Section 5. Any zoning authority authorized pursuant to this act shall be undertaken in accordance with Chapter 52 of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 6. The provisions of this act are severable. If any part of the act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

Section 7. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 8. This act shall become effective
immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
upon its otherwise becoming a law.
