SYNOPSIS:

Birmingham will host the 2025 World Police and Fire Games, an international sports event where public safety officers, police officers, firefighters, and emergency medical technicians from around the world will compete.

Each of the participating teams, in addition to competing athletes, may include in its delegation trainers and doctors to care for the competitors and their coaches.

This bill establishes a limited exemption from licensure, registration, and certification requirements for nonresident medical professionals who are licensed in their home state or nation and credentialed by the Games to provide health services during the events.

This bill would also provide procedures for authorizing consent of a minor athlete to receive hospital, medical, or surgical care.

This bill would only be in effect until the end of 2025.

Relating to licensure of health care professionals; to exempt certain individuals from state licensure, registration, and certification requirements while they are visiting Alabama to render certain services during the 2025 World Police and Fire Games to be held in Birmingham and other locations; to provide for consent for certain medical services; and to provide for repeal of this bill on December 31,

- 38 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- Section 1. (a) As used in this section, the following terms have the following meanings:
- (1) CREDENTIAL or CREDENTIALED. The grant or receipt of credentials by the Birmingham Host Committee of the 2025 World Police and Fire Games.
- department or equivalent organization represented by a
 delegation of athletes, coaches, trainers, and other
 credentialed support staff and officials which is
 participating in the 2025 World Police and Fire Games.
- 49 (3) GAMES. The 2025 World Police and Fire Games to be 50 held in Birmingham, Alabama.
- (4) THE GAMES FAMILY. Any credentialed athletes,
 coaches, trainers, or other credentialed support staff and
 officials of the Birmingham Host Committee of the 2025 World
 Police and Fire Games, the California Police Athletic
 Federation, a department, or individuals with entities
 affiliated with the games, including judges and juries.



- 57 (5) WPFG. The Birmingham Host Committee of the 2025 58 World Police and Fire Games.
- (b) Nothing in Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be construed to require licensure, registration, or certification of individuals who are nonresidents of this state, who hold a current and valid professional license, certificate, registration, or other authorization to practice any profession regulated under Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, from any state or nation, and who are credentialed by WPFG to render care or to provide services to athletes or other members of the games family in connection with the games and its events.

- (c) Whenever the services authorized under subsection (b) are health care services, the services shall only be provided to the games family at the sites designated by WPFG. Individuals exempted by subsection (b) who provide health care services shall provide services only to members of the games family at the sites designated by WPFG. Individuals exempted by subsection (b) who provide health care services shall provide those services only to those members of the games family who are also members of that individual's sponsoring department as credentialed by WPFG.
- (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize or grant individuals who are hospital medical staff privileges at any hospital, ambulatory surgery center, outpatient care center, or other health care facility located in the State of Alabama.
 - (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each



- 85 department may designate to WPFG, who shall in turn 86 appropriately credential an official delegate who may give consent to hospital, medical, and surgical care to a minor who 87 88 is a team member for that department's team, and that consent 89 shall not be subject to disaffirmance because of minority. The 90 consent of the parent or parents of that minor shall not be 91 necessary in order to authorize hospital, medical, or surgical 92 care.
- 93 (f) This section is repealed on December 31, 2025.
- 94 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately 95 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 96 otherwise becoming law.
