A brief of an amicus curiae, pursuant 25 to this section, shall only be prepared and filed by the staff 26

of the Legislative Services Agency. A brief of an amicus
curiae shall only be filed for civil cases.

3 Section 2. It is the intent of the Legislature, 4 pursuant to Section 6.11 of Amendment 328 of the Constitution 5 of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 150 of the 6 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 7 as amended, that this act supersede any inconsistent rule of 8 appellate procedure adopted by the Alabama Supreme Court.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the 11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
