4 Relating to design professionals; to add Section
5 41-9A-3.1 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to require an agreement
6 with a design professional who does not have professional
7 liability insurance coverage to disclose that fact in writing
8 to the client, who shall sign and notarize the disclosure.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Section 41-9A-3.1 is added to the Code of
11 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

12 §41-9A-3.1

13 Before entering into a verbal or written agreement to
14 provide services, a design professional, as defined in Section
15 41-9A-3(a), who is not covered by professional liability
16 insurance, shall disclose that fact in writing to the client.
17 The disclosure shall be signed by the client and notarized
18 before the design professional may perform any work for that
19 client.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
21 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
22 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
